→ STRIKE AND BALL COUNT

→ BATTER/RUNNER GOES OUT

→ BATTER GETS ON BASE AND SCORES

→ THE OUT SHOWN BY A CIRCLED NUMBER (e.g., THE SECOND OUT OF THE INNING)

→ BATTER GETS ON BASE BUT DOES NOT SCORE

→ SOLID LINE INDICATES END OF INNING

→ FIRST BATTER IN 2ND INNING

→ PLAYER SUBSTITUTION (e.g., #47 REPLACED #29 IN THE 4TH INNING)

→ ALTERNATE PLAYERS

→ TOTAL RUNS SCORED IN INNING

→ PITCHER (JERSEY # OR NAME) AND INNINGS PITCHED

- BEFORE AND DURING GAME** (arrive 20 minutes before game start):

 - Open window shutter of scorekeeping hut
 - Collect batting line-up from a coach for each team
 - Enter jersey number and name for each player for both teams in scorebook lineup column
 - Use a pencil (not a pen)
 - Pay particular attention to the strike and ball count (the umpire expects this)

AFTER GAME

 - Record the final score in the scorebook
 - Close window shutter
