Stong's Tournament Rules

May 20 – 22, 2017

Each team will play one game on each of the three days of the tournament.

Tournament Specific Rules

Regular season Little League Rules for Majors will apply for the tournament with the following exceptions:

- No intentional walks
- Each team will bat thru the line-up (1-12)
- Each child plays minimum 3 of the 6 innings in the field
- A pitcher can pitch maximum 2 innings per game (6 outs constitutes 2 innings)
- Each game you must use at least one pitcher who is not a baseball 12 year old and they need to pitch 6 outs. These outs do not need to be consecutive assuming you are using different pitchers.
- If you call up a child from another team he/she cannot pitch
- No composite barrel bats will be allowed. Composite handle bats are OK.
- We'd ask that coaches identify on their line-up card who are the non 12 years olds but it will be somewhat on the honour system
- We will not use a pitch count and therefore you can go from pitcher to catcher after your 2 innings
- To keep on schedule, no new inning will start after 1hr 45min of duration. . The final game is the exception with a 2 hr 15 min time limit.

Key requests:

- **We ask that every team (including the visiting teams) provide one adult scorekeeper for the game in which your team is playing.**
- **We would also ask that each non-Dunbar Little League team bring a dozen (unused) baseballs for tournament use (think of it as your tournament entrance fee).**
