

## **DLL 2021 BASEBALL COVID SAFETY VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES**

### **Event participants:**

- **Every single player, coach and manager, without exception has to fill in their availability in TeamSnap and have completed the health check. Health check available the day of the activity in the TeamSnap app. If they have not, then they will not be allowed on the field. No exceptions. We have to keep meticulous contact tracing records.**
- **Safety Volunteers who are not rostered on TeamSnap can complete an online COVID screen available under the safety tab on the DLL website (<https://dunbarbaseball.ca>)**
- Before any event is to start, all participants must have their hands sanitized by the Safety Volunteer.
- Coaches/managers/safety volunteers need to wear masks. Optional but recommended for players.
- Social distancing measures must be in place between all participants.
- **It is the duty of the Safety Volunteer to control all sanitizing events before and after the events**

### **Equipment:**

- Personal bats are strongly encouraged. DLL has team bats available if needed and should be used by the same single child per session. If sharing of bats is required then the safety volunteer can help sanitize between players.
- DLL league catchers equipment is to be used by the same single player per session. Catcher's gear cannot be shared between participants in the same session and must be sanitized after each event.
- Any other equipment must be sanitized before and after use. Balls used during practice should be wiped down whenever possible.
- Field Prep equipment is to be disinfected before and cleaned after every use
- Disinfectant (wipe down) any other surfaces as needed.
- Encourage participants to wipe down their own equipment.

### **Sanitizing supplies to be used/supplied**

- Hand Sanitizer for all participants "HANDS ONLY"
- Disposable gloves
- Disposable Face covering (Masks)
- Either Lysol wipes or a ready to use cleaning solution will be available at all diamonds for sanitizing equipment.
